In the event of an area wide disaster, critical infrastructure and emergency services will be impacted. The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) academy trains residents to prepare for and respond to life-threatening events in their community. CERT members can mobilize neighborhood resources, deliver immediate assistance to victims, organize emergency communications and provide support to first responders. Valley Center has a well organized and active CERT program. CERT members prepare, organize and work together as a team to provide essential services to their community during and after a disaster. CERT strengthens neighborhood resiliency and plays a vital role in our town's disaster response efforts.

CERT training academies are offered in the area served by the Valley Center Fire Protection District and rotate throughout the year. Some of the skills taught include organizing resources, medical operations, emergency radio operations, basic search and rescue, how to use a fire extinguisher and damage assessment.
